Your artillery piece needs to be on the event grounds by Friday night if possible. Please have your artillery on the inspection field as soon as reasonably possible following your arrival. Only full-scale, authentic artillery pieces will be allowed to participate in any activities involving firing of weapons or interpretation to the public.)

RULES: Cannons will not be allowed off the battlefield until after all foot traffic by spectators has cleared. **NO CARS** are allowed to park in the cannon parking area or in the authentic area of artillery camp.

Your artillery camp coordinator is Bob Farrar. The overall commander for artillery will conduct inspections of all artillery pieces to be fired. No artillery pieces may be fired without first being inspected.
